



Android Email Settings

You can no longer setup email on the Galaxy stock app after their most recent software update; you will now need to go to the Google Play Store and download K-9 Mail. The same applies for most Android devices.

> Open the email client. If it doesn't immediately prompt you to add an account, then press Menu -> More -> Accounts. Press Menu again -> Add Account:
